- An agreement can be canceled by you according to conditions of your License Agreement;
- In case you need to make your next purchase earlier than as per the payment schedule, you may pay separately or please contact your manager to correct your payment schedule or amount.

- NSYS Group partners with Worldpay to facilitate card payments and other payments and the disbursement of funds to sellers. The provider and processing time for your payment will vary based on the country in which you're located. If there are insufficient funds in your bank account when our provider processes the payment for your purchase, NSYS Group reserves the right to contact you directly and to seek payment.
- NSYS Group may share your personal or transactional information with those third-party service providers when it's necessary to process payments.
